# Discussion on the Reasons for the Decline of the Marriage Rate in China

A total of 2.107 million couples registered for marriage in the first quarter of 2022, down 1.17 percent year-on-year, according to data. If this trend continues, it is expected that the marriage rate will continue to decline in the future. The reasons for this phenomenon are linked to sky-high bride prices, a skewed male-to-female ratio, women's increasing independence, changing attitudes towards marriage, the high cost of marriage and childbearing, and high pressure at work. Young people who are not married and have children will accelerate the aging process of our country, the imbalanced age structure of the population, and will eventually cause the demographic dividend of our country to disappear.

#### 1. Sky-High Bride Price

- (1) The cause of the sky-high bride price
- ① The imbalance of male to female ratio is an important reason for the appearance of the skyhigh bride price. With more men and fewer women, women have more choices in the marriage market, while men are in a passive position. To get married, they have to pay the high cost of marriage, which leads to the sky-high bride price[1].
- ② Compare with each other. In some rural areas. The face is very important and many villagers believe that the more the bride price they pay, the more valuable their daughter will be and the more face they will have. In this kind of comparison, vanity faces competition, resulting in the wind of skyhigh bride prices being more serious.
- ③ Trading psychology. Some parents with strong roots in traditional thinking think that "the married daughter will throw water" and treat the daughter as a "commodity to be traded". After the daughter gets married, the family will be less, and the husband can only use money as a reward.
  - (2) The consequences of the sky-high bride price
- ① Young people can't afford to marry. The bride price and dowry are originally a beautiful thing for two families to support a new family, but now the bride price has changed. The appearance of the

sky-high bride price makes many young men shy away from marriage and want to get married. However, because the bride price is too expensive, they cannot afford to get married, which directly leads to the decline of the marriage rate in China[2].

- ② It has worsened the ethos of the countryside. In many rural areas, the bride price is more than 100,000 yuan, 200,000 yuan, or even more than 300,000 yuan. Many people regard it as a custom. Under blind comparison and following the trend, it has become a bad habit, which has worsened the atmosphere in rural areas.
- ③ It has caused social instability, To afford the high price of bride price, some families choose to use usurious loans, and some even turn to crimes. As a result, many families are broken because of the bride price, which has seriously affected them. Social harmony and stability.

#### 2. Gender Imbalance

- (1) The reason for the imbalance of male to female ratio
- ① There is a preference for sons in some areas. The old feudal thought, the son can carry on the family line, the daughter is domesticated for others. In ancient times, it was men who stood up and believed that if they did not give birth to a son. They would have no future, and if they did not give birth to a daughter, they would have nothing to do with their family. Even in modern times, people in some areas still have this idea, because of this abnormal concept, some places have more men than women.

Accounting for 51.0% and 58.0% respectively. So it's a symbolic thing that women are becoming more independent.

## 4. High cost of marriage and childbearing

- (1) The reason for the high cost of marriage and childbearing
- ① Housing prices are high. In the past 20 years since the housing reform, the housing price has increased by ten or even dozens of times, while people's wages have only increased by several times, and prices are on the rise. It is not easy for young people to pay enough to support themselves. Therefore, it is not an easy thing for ordinary families to buy a house. Hollowed all, most people are again to accept higher interest on loans in two hundred and thirty to have their housing, this isn't one thousand prices fell to watching if family assets, the house abandoned me neither housing have to on time according to the original loan amount on the contract the various risks of reimbursement. And in this era, buying a house seems to have become a necessity for marriage, so the high housing price makes many young people shy away from getting married.
  - ② High bride price.
- ③ The cost of raising children is high. According to the China ChildBearing Cost Report, the average cost of raising a child until the age of 18 is 485,000 yuan, and parents still pay most of the cost of living after the child goes to university. In China, the average cost of raising a child in college for four years is 142,000 yuan, from birth to College graduates, raising a child needs at least 600,000. (As shown in table 1)These are just some of the basic expenses. The specific costs of raising a child are as follows:
- (2) First of all, the money a newborn baby needs to spend, such on milk powder, baby's clothes, toys, etc., because it is a small baby, so eating, wearing, use and other aspects have extra attention, especially milk powder, most of them are 200-300 yuan/can, a little more expensive 400-600 yuan/can have. Many parents want to give their children good, so the baby is born, it will cost a lot of money. [1]
- (3)Time cost. The most direct time cost is maternity leave. Most enterprises pay for maternity leave as usual. Recently, some provinces have revised the regulations of the freshmen plan, and some regions have extended maternity leave and added childcare leave. Although the extension of maternity leave will help women have more time to look after children, which is conducive to family child-rearing, if all the costs brought by the extension of maternity leave are borne by enterprises, it will inevitably lead to enterprises trying to avoid hiring women of childbearing age, thus exacerbating gender discrimination among women in the job market.

- (4) Opportunity cost. Although the provision of maternity leave, a very practical problem is that if the maternity leave is too long, it will lead to a long-term disconnect between female workers and the workplace, return to work, will encounter a variety of difficulties and discrimination, their ability may also be reduced, affecting their competitiveness in the work. At present, the time and opportunity costs of raising children in Chinese families are mainly borne by women, who find it difficult to raise children while juggling heavy work in the workplace. At present, the social environment in China is not friendly to women's childbearing. The time cost and opportunity cost for women to bear children is very high.
- (5) High cost of education. Although it is now nine-year compulsory education, nominally it is saving a lot of money it is not so. With the change of The Times, the education competition is very fierce, many parents in order not to let their children lose at the starting line, the children have not been to kindergarten began to attend a variety of early education or interest classes, of course, these cost money and very expensive, some one-to-one tutoring is hundreds of yuan an hour. It's fine to go to a public school, but if you go to a private school, it's a lot of money, so the cost of raising a child is very, very high.
- (6) Usually food, clothing, housing, and transportation are expenses. From the birth of children to their stable work, the parents have to bear the food, clothing, housing, and transportation for more than ten or even twenty years. Some parents insist that they would rather suffer for themselves than their children, and give the best to their children, which is undoubtedly a high cost.
- (7) Children get married, another expensive cost. If the family is a girl pressure is OK, if it is a boy, and to car house, and bride price is a very large expenditure

At present, the employment pressure of young people is mainly from the competition of peers. Because there are too many peers, and peers are very excellent, so many young people feel that they are not competitive in employment, only not to improve themselves, constantly hone their own, it is possible to have their place in such a volume of society. If you can't afford a house, you can't get married. It's a vicious cycle. Always work hard but can't see the hope, will feel very tired and want to give up. Then came the living conditions of lying flat and Buddha. It's not that I don't want to work hard, but the goal of buying a house and getting married is too far away to reach on tiptoe.
